Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival at Paro

Welcome to Bhutan:

Depart for Base of Tiger's Nest: Travel to the trailhead with your guide. The drive is short, and you'll be at the starting point of the hike promptly.

Begin the Hike: The hike to Tiger's Nest is about 4 km each way and takes approximately 2 hours to ascend, depending on your pace. The path is steep in some sections but well-trodden and accessible.

Cafeteria Stop: There is a cafeteria located halfway up the trail. It's a good spot to take a break and enjoy some refreshments while taking in the stunning view of the monastery, which appears almost glued to the cliff face opposite.

Arrival and Exploration: Once you reach the monastery, spend some time exploring the sacred site. Your guide will provide insights into its history and the legends associated with Guru Rinpoche's miraculous introduction of Buddhism to Bhutan.

Lunch:

Descend to Cafeteria: After touring the monastery, hike back down to the cafeteria for lunch, enjoying the breathtaking views of the valley below.

Afternoon Sightseeing in Paro:

Drive Back to Paro: Once you have descended to the base, your guide will drive you back to Paro.

Visit Paro Dzong: Also known as Rinpung Dzong, this fortress serves as a religious and administrative center. Explore the dzong's impressive architecture and learn about its role in the district.

Explore Kyichu Lhakhang: One of the oldest temples in Bhutan, dating back to the 7th century. This site provides a peaceful and spiritual experience, reflecting the ancient heritage of Bhutanese Buddhism.
